October 20th-21st

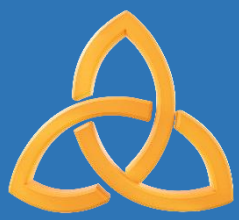
Please note that on **October 20th-21st**, there will be no busing provided to students in either the morning or afternoon as the public schools will not be in session.

Chili Cook Off and Reformation Party

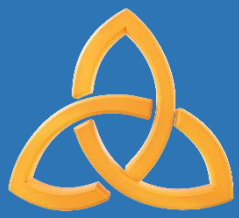
Trinity Lutheran is hosting a Chili Cook Off and a Reformation Party on **Sunday, October 30th**.
