KING's Choir

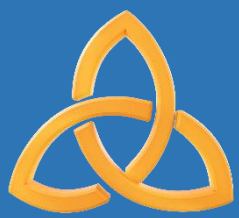
KING's Choir will not be meeting for practice the next two weeks, **November 22nd** or **November 29th**.

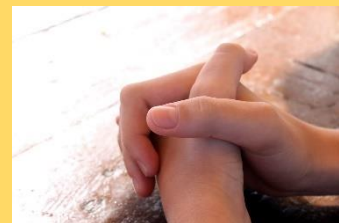

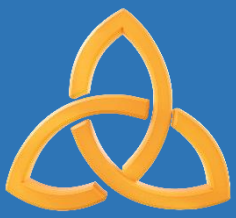
